Art fairs to go in April

Milan, 14 - 16 April 2023

The modern and contemporary art fair returns to Milan for the 27th time. miart boasts the presence of 169 galleries from 27 countries around the world, with foreign participation over forty percent. The fair will be divided in three sections - from *Emergent*, populated by 26 young exhibitors, to *Established*, the main section with 133 galleries and dedicated to the art of the 20th and 21st centuries, ending with *Decades*, which will retrace, through ten projects, the history of art from the first decade of 1900 to the first decade of the third millennium. After *Dismantling silence* in 2021 and starting the *First movement* of a possible new symphony the following year, miart continues in the vein of musical metaphors with a 2023 edition shaped around the word *Crescendo*. It probably refers to the growth - in terms of quality, participation, audience - seen between the previous two editions and it really is full of promises.

Urban Art Fair

Paris, 13 - 16 April 2023

Urban Art Fair, the first international street art fair, returns to the Carreau du Temple, in the heart of Paris, for its 7th edition. It was in 2016 that Yannick Boesso gave life to this large-scale project which aims to highlight the international urban scene. 2023 marks a real turning point for the fair, which relies on a demanding selection committee made up of professionals from the sector. Among the 36 influential galleries participating in this exceptional edition, 21 will present solo shows by major artists of the movement such as Invader, Blek Le Rat, Hopare, Lek & Sowat, Vhils, Franck Noto, Gerard Zlotykamien, Astro, Miss Tic, Ernest Pignon Ernest, André Saravia, Miss Van, Jef Aérosol, JonOne and many others. Art Brussels

Brussels, 20 - 23 April 2023

Founded in 1968, Art Brussels is one of the oldest contemporary art fairs in Europe. Over the years, the fair has established itself as an essential event that welcomes nearly 25,000 visitors each year. Collectors, gallery owners, curators, art professionals and art lovers from all over the world come to discover the richness of the artistic and cultural scene in the European capital. This year, the fair returns to the site of Brussels Expo, an Art Deco icon built for the 1935 Brussels International Exhibition. The 178 international galleries are divided into 3 sections and 1 sub-section. DISCOVERY focuses on young, emerging and lesser-known artists with recent works (2017-2020). PRIME presents established artists, from modern to contemporary. REDISCOVERY is

exclusive installations, meetings and live performances throughout the four days of the fair. Urban Art Fair is a qualitative fair on a human scale, which is not only for street art lovers!

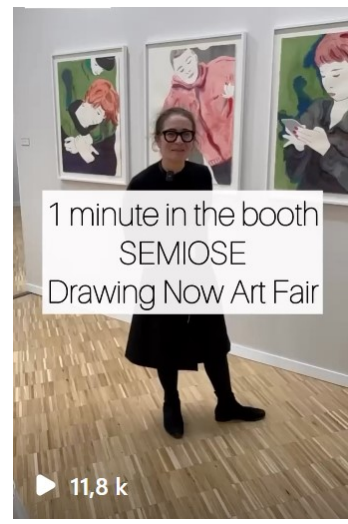
