




Dear fairgoers,

## TEFAF New York



### NYC, May 12 - 16, 2023

It is already the 9th edition of TEFAF New York, which will take place as usual at the Park Avenue Armory. Around one hundred established international galleries will participate. The works of art and collectibles are of different styles, periods, cultures and media. TEFAF New York will once again offer art lovers, collectors, museum and design professionals the opportunity to experience spaces in the Armory's captivating period rooms. Part of the TEFAF New York 2023 schedule, *TEFAF Programming* will offer conversations, discover and discuss industry insights and trends, and inspire new and experienced art collectors and lovers. The expo will also host side events dedicated to sustainability, the future of art fairs and other exciting topics.

## Future Fair

**NYC, May 10 – 13, 2023**

Officially launched in 2020, with physical editions in 2021 and 2022, Future Fair is one of New York's youngest fairs. Unique in its profit-sharing model, Future Fair defines itself as a platform committed to exploring and producing in-person and digital collaborations and initiatives that champion pioneering artists who actively advance culture. For its third edition, it will take place at Chelsea Industrial and will welcome over 50 local, national, and international exhibitors, presenting compelling curated and solo projects. With the ethos of community and shared camaraderie, the fair has become one of the most anticipated events among collectors and art lovers alike.

## NADA

**NYC, May 18 – 21, 2023**

For its 9th edition, NADA New York moves to West Chelsea and gathers for the occasion, 88 exhibitors – galleries, art spaces and non-profit organizations – from the United States and around the world will gather. Drawn from 17 countries and 37 cities, the participating galleries include 53 NADA Members and 31 first-time exhibitors. Alongside the fair itself, *NADA Presents* will feature the conversations, performances and events that have made this fair so popular. In a statement, NADA director Heather Hubbs said, "New York City is a global art center and our home base as a gallery association. We're delighted to continue showcasing key voices and unique presentations in contemporary art and look forward to welcoming visitors to our new location for our ninth edition this May."

## Frieze New York



**NYC, May 17 – 21, 2023**

After last year's sold-out edition, Frieze New York returns to the Shed in Manhattan. The fair brings together 65 galleries and the most influential and talked about artists. In keeping with its tradition, the fair features a strong core of New York galleries and the artists they represent. New director Christine Messineo, also announced the return of The Frame section, which supports galleries with ten years or less of existence to present solo work by today's

most important artists. In addition, a special edition of Frieze Viewing Room will run alongside the fair, connecting international galleries with audiences around the world.
